## Restricting Information Available to Facebook Applications

By default, Facebook allows applications access to almost all your personal details. This will include applications installed by friends not just your own applications.

Applications are not created or controlled by Facebook. They are supplied by 3<sup>rd</sup> parties so you must take care.

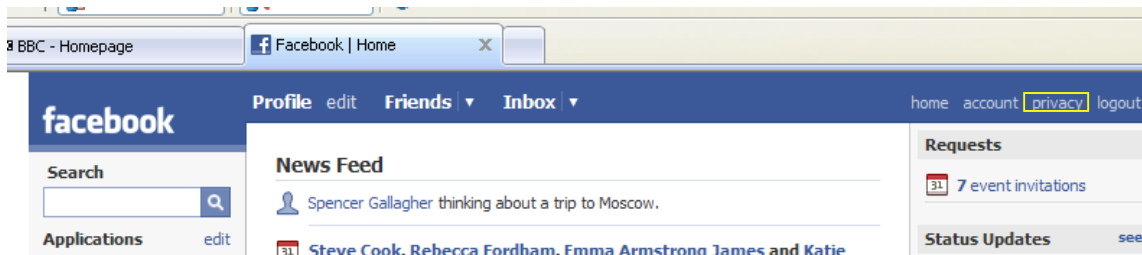
How to control access

Step 1

Log in as usual

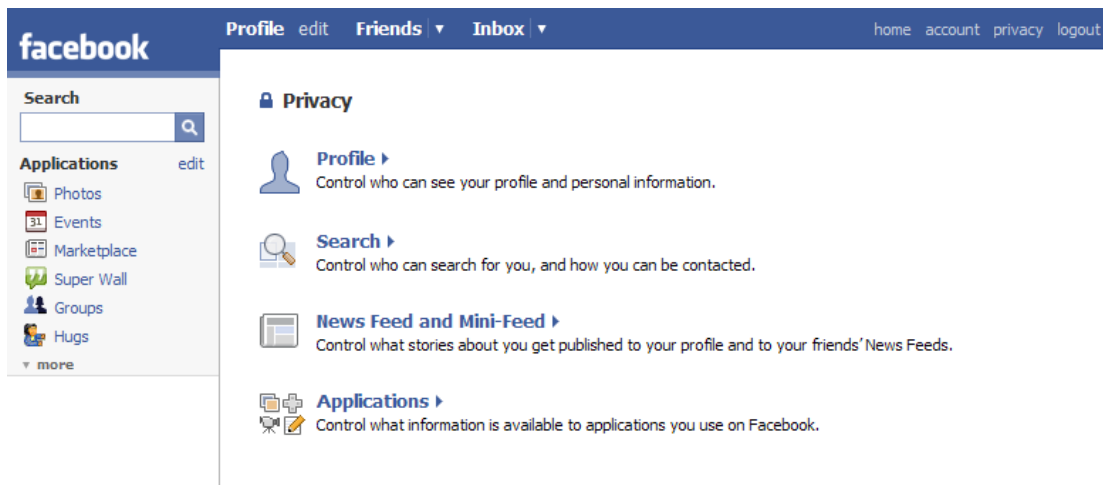
Step 2

Click on 'Privacy' – top right menu. Highlighted here by the yellow box

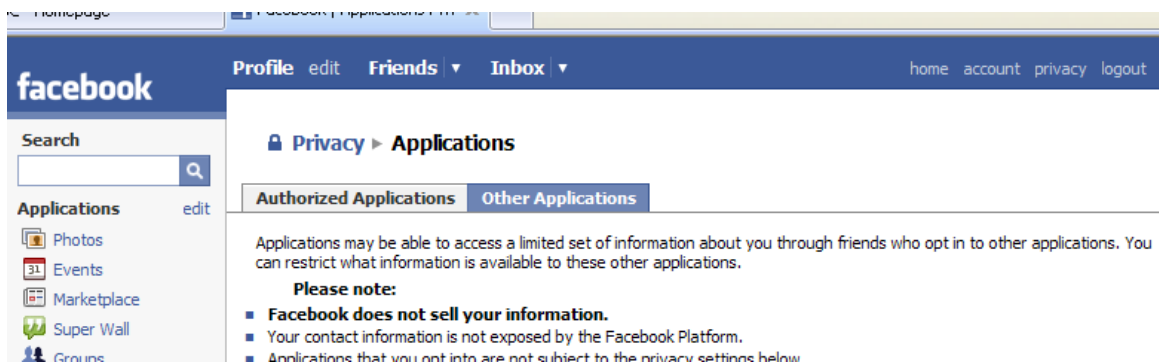


Step 3

Click on 'Applications'



Step 4  
Click on 'Other Applications'

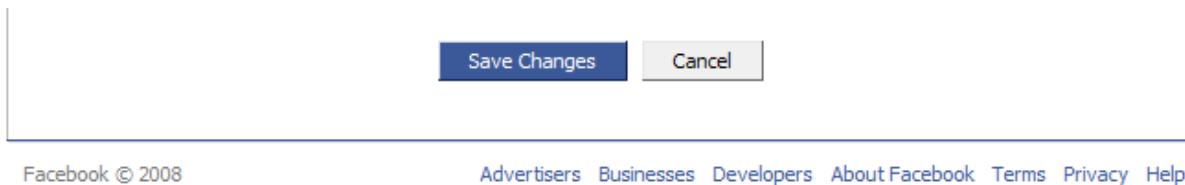


Step 5  
Select the information you want to make available or unavailable.

Note: you can only block everything if you have no applications installed. If you want to choose this option you will need to remove all applications first.

Step 6  
You may also want to check 'Authorized Applications'  
There are times when applications appear here that you have NOT installed. Remove them if you are not using them.

Step 7  
To make sure any changes are stored and applied you must click on 'Save Changes' before moving away from the page



Other options  
If you go back to Step 3 you will see there are other privacy options. It would be wise to check these other settings
